- in 2012, target SCP Forum is National Action Plan, included to develop information infrastructure intertegrated with *Indonesia SCP Resource Pool*.

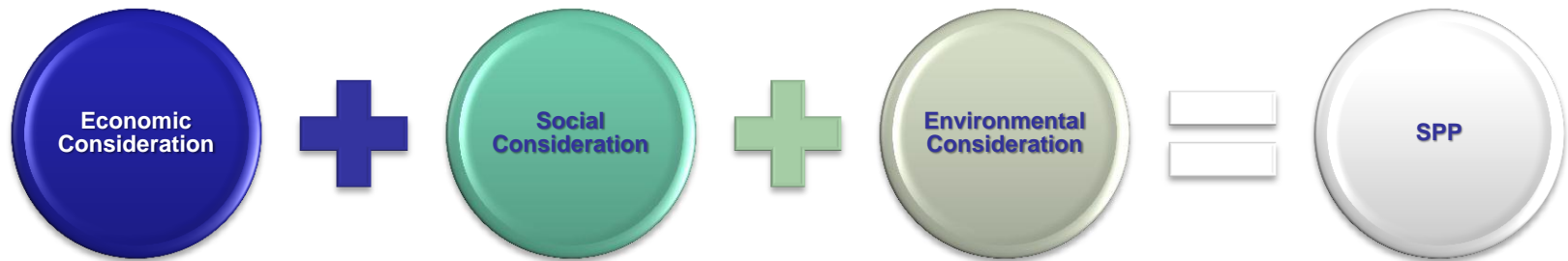
SCP, INDONESIA (2)

Presidential Regulation No. 70 of year 2012

Presidential Regulation No 54 of Year 2010 , amended partially through Presidential Regulation No. 70 of year 2012 regarding Public Procurement stipulate the need to promote sustainable public procurement as stated in the article 105 as follows:

Para 1

- Eco-friendly concept is a process of meeting the needs of goods and services of government organizations (K/L/D/I), so that the entire steps of procurement process can provide benefits to the government organization (K/L/D/I) and the community and the economy, with minimum impact to the environmental.

Para 2

- The concept of eco-friendly in public procurement **can be** applied in the bidding documents in the form of certain requirements, which may lead to the use of natural resources wisely and support the preservation of the environment in accordance with the characteristics of the job.

Para 3

- Eco - friendly public procurement as referred to in paragraph 2, conducted with attention to the efficiency and effectiveness of the procurement (value for money).

Our Potential/ Opportunity

Government expenditure:

- From around \$1,500 billion of state budget, estimated around 30 % spent through public procurement process.

Awareness to preserve our environment:

- Reducing carbon emission is one of example the rising awareness among the government institution as a response to the catastrophic caused by global climate change.
