Project Overview

Under the Thai-German Programme on Energy Efficiency Development Plan (TGP-EEDP), the Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit GmbH – GIZ – is cooperating with the Energy Policy and Planning Office (EPPO) under the Thai Ministry of Energy, to contribute to the further development and support the implementation of Thailand's Energy Efficiency Plan (EEDP 2011-2030 and EEP, 2015-2036). The project is funded through the International Climate Initiative (ICI) Fund of the German Federal Ministry for Environment, Nature Conservation, Building and Nuclear Safety. The TGP-EEDP project aims at promoting the increase of energy efficiency in industry and building sectors to create a direct impact on CO₂ emission reduction.

Since the TGP-EEDP started in May 2013, it supported Thailand's Energy Efficiency Plan in four main activities: (1) energy baseline and data management; (2) mandatory approaches to energy efficiency; (3) energy efficiency incentive instruments; and (4) integration of energy efficiency and climate policy. More in general, the programme contributed to international knowledge transfer and capacity building on energy efficiency for a diverse range of Thai stakeholders.
