Qualifications

Education and technical understanding

- Bachelor's or master's degree in a field related to the project namely: sustainability, management, energy, transport, environment, economics, other related fields;

- Knowledge of one of the following issues would be an advantage: Policy landscape, sustainability ambitions, policy and regulation, innovative business models in the area of Thailand energy transition.

Professional experience

- Experience in building and maintaining contact networks with private and public sector stakeholders and ability to facilitate project design and manage cooperation projects;
